### PUBLIC HEARING

#### **Regarding Use of CDBG Funds for FY 2014 Colonias Set Aside Funds**

The Town of Wellton intends to apply for FY 2014 CDBG Colonia Set Aside funds in the amount of \$566,400 from the Arizona Department of Housing. CDBG Colonia Set Aside funds must be used in designated Colonia areas and address the lack of basic infrastructure or safe and sanitary housing. It must also benefit low-income persons and areas, alleviate slum and blight or address urgent need.

A public hearing will be held to gather citizen input on the use of the CDBG Colonia Set Aside funds on:

**WHERE:** Wellton Town Hall, 28634 Oakland Avenue  
Wellton, Arizona.

Examples of possible activities that qualify as colonia projects include the following:

- Address the lack of decent, safe, and sanitary housing (Housing Rehabilitation or Emergency Repair);
- Address the lack of potable water supply (water infrastructure construction);
- Address the lack of adequate sewage systems (Sewer Infrastructure and/or Sewer Connections under Housing Rehabilitation);
- Planning for Waste Water Treatment improvements; and
- Planning for Potable Water Delivery improvements.
